The Fourth Annual Survey Exhibition

This juried exhibition is open to all artists using photographic processes: analog or digital, color or B&W, alternative processes and mixed media explorations. **Contemporary Photography Hawai'i 2012** is meant to offer artists who use photography a venue for exhibiting work and to provide a snapshot of the "state of the art" of contemporary photography in Hawai'i.

Hawai'i residents, amateurs and professionals, are welcome to submit images. Works must show evidence of a photographic process in their creation.

Requirements

- Images must have been created within the past two years and not previously exhibited in Hawai'i.
- Photographers living in the state of Hawai'i who are 18 and older are eligible.
- Work must be original. Selected work must be printed for the exhibition.
- Frames and mattes: You will need to provide your own framing for the exhibition.

Frames up to 24" X 30" will be accepted. If you need assistance with framing, Frame Arts Hawaii is offering a 25% discount to exhibition participants. Please make arrangements with Frame Arts at least 10 days before the due date. We recommend simple, unobtrusive matting and framing for consistency in the exhibition.

Maximum 5 images.
Register/Pay for submission at
www.outreach.hawaii.edu/pnmphoto or call 956-8400.
2. Email images with the following information to
pnmphoto@gmail.com.
Submit images in jpg format. Please create files in your image
editing program so the LONGEST dimension is 1200 pixels.
Maximum size of the file: 2 megabytes.

The jurors will not see the names of the submitting artists, only the
image and its title. Please remember to fill in the title field.

For print sales, Frame Arts Hawaii will take a 25% sales commission.

Pacific New Media will host a short workshop on
Thursday February 23, 2012, from 6-8pm, to assist
photographers in editing and preparing images
for submission. Participants are welcome to prepare
files in the PNM lab for submission. ***If you are unsure
about any of the requirements, please attend this
workshop.***
